



Guidelines for Visiting Christ the King School for Basketball



Greetings Athletic Directors, Coaches & Spectators,

Below are the guidelines for playing games at Christ the King School. It is imperative that we adhere to these guidelines to maintain the safety and health of all participating. Failure to do so may result in a player/coach/spectator/parent being asked to leave the premises or cancellation of future contests. Spectators will be allowed at CKS Home Games.

- A roster of players, coaches, scorebook keepers & their phone numbers will need to be provided BEFORE arrival in case of the need for contact tracing.
- Masks are to be worn at all times by everyone, spectators included. CKS will not provide masks.
- Spectators are allowed in the building to watch the games. Please limit the number of family members that come as we ask that proper social distancing be maintained.
- Players/spectators will not have access to the school; they are to remain in the gymnasium.
- CKS will have four different bathrooms for players and coaches to use, but players need to come dressed to play.
- Spectators will not be allowed to bring in food or drinks.
- Players and coaches will be socially distanced when on the sidelines.
- Players are to be directly supervised by their coach if arriving on a bus.
- Players should bring their own water bottles (CKS has no drinking fountains available).
- Teams will not be permitted to shoot during halftime of games.
- Visiting teams should bring their own basketballs for warm ups (CKS will not provide them). There will only be 5 minutes to warm up.
- If your school does bus your athletes, then both teams are allowed in the gym.
- If you do not bus your athletes then please only show up 10 minutes before your game time.

We reserve the right to limit the number of spectators and/or not allow spectators if needed.
